FARMINGTON, UT (May 5, 2026) – Western Sports Park, Northern Utah’s destination for youth sports and sports tourism, has announced a new partnership with CommonSpirit Health. The room is open to all athletes who compete at WSP. And just outside the training room, CommonSpirit is also sponsoring an open lounge area complete with charging stations. It will provide a relaxing space for athletes and their family members to gather in between events.

Western Sports Park recently opened in Farmington following a multi-year campus expansion designed to increase sports tourism opportunities in Davis County and across Northern Utah. The complex features six full-sized athletic fields, including a championship field with 2,000-seat bleachers. It also includes the newly named CommonSpirit Center, an indoor facility with two multipurpose arenas and stadium seating.

Commissioner Bob Stevenson said, “This partnership represents the kind of collaboration that makes projects like Western Sports Park possible. By working together with CommonSpirit Health, we are strengthening our commitment to community, health, and long-term economic growth in Davis County.”
